

The Vehicle Access for Wolverhampton Railway Station is Changing

From Sunday, January 8, 2017, the way vehicles access City of Wolverhampton Railway Station will change in line with the opening of a new entrance to the extended and refurbished multi-storey car park.

There will no longer be any access to Railway Drive for vehicles. Pedestrians and cyclists should use the access route off Pipers Row.

HOW TO ACCESS THE RAILWAY STATION FROM 8 JANUARY 2017

▶ Travelling from Stafford Road (A449) direction:

Follow Ring Road St Patricks, onto Ring Road St Davids and take slip road/exit onto Corn Hill.

▶ Travelling from Wednesfield Road (A4124) direction:

Follow Ring Road St Davids (A4150) and take slip road/exit onto Corn Hill.

▶ Travelling from Willenhall Road (A454) direction:

Follow A454 into city centre, straight on at the Horseley Fields lights and right onto Corn Hill.

▶ Travelling from Bilston Island direction:

Take the A454 Middle Cross exit, left at the Horseley Fields (A454) lights and right onto Corn Hill.
